



**Excise Movement Control System
Internet Filing Enabled Software**

Instructions for Gaining Internet Recognition

Software Developer Support Team

Introduction

Once you have completed your own thorough product testing you can apply for Internet Recognition for your Excise Movement Control System submission product.

Recognition

There will be a four phase process to become fully recognised for EMCS.

- Initial – This involves software houses informing the software developers support team that they intend to produce an EMCS solution.
- FS0 – As below
- FS1 – To Be Advised
- FS2 – To be Advised

Once you have generated the XML for the scenarios and you want to apply for recognition for your Excise Movement Control System software, you must supply:

1. XML examples of two submission messages for each message class.
For FS0 these message classes are:
 - **AcknowledgeMessagesReceipt**
 - **GetMovementForTrader**
 - **GetNewMessages**
 - **SubmitExplainDelayToDelivery**
 - **SubmitReportofReceipt**
2. XML examples of two submit_responses from LTS for each message class, these should include the HMRC mark receipt where applicable.
For FS0 these message classes that include the HMRC mark are:
 - **SubmitExplainDelayToDelivery**
 - **SubmitReportofReceipt**
3. Written/email confirmation that developers have tested the ability to submit SOAP calls and retrieve messages

Please ensure each case is noted with the correct title.

The SDS Team will examine the XML to ensure that the product is capable of sending Excise Movement Control System software via the Local Test Service and if successful the product will be granted Internet Recognition.

The recognition process is to be used primarily to ensure that software packages can produce correct XML instances. Successful submission of these recognition cases will result in HM Revenue & Customs Recognition for your submission product but it does not constitute any form of HM Revenue & Customs approval of an Excise Movement Control System product itself.
