## Extending payment of Child Benefit

### How do I qualify for the extension?

We can extend Child Benefit for up to 20 weeks for young people who have left full-time non advanced education or approved training if:

- they are under age 18 **and** they have either:
  - registered for work, education or training with the Careers Service or Connexions Service, in Northern Ireland the Department for Employment and Learning or an Education and Library Board, or any corresponding body in another European Union member state, **or**
  - applied to join HM Forces and are awaiting placement from the Ministry of Defence

**and**

- they are not doing paid work for 24 hours or more a week
- they are not receiving Income Support, income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, Incapacity Benefit, Employment & Support Allowance or tax credits in their own right
- the extension period for that young person has not expired
- immediately before the extension period begins you are entitled to Child Benefit for the young person **and**
- you have made a **written request** for the extension **within three months** of the end of education or training.

Please note that registration for training with the training provider **does not** qualify a young person for the extension of Child Benefit.

### How long will the extension period last?

We can pay Child Benefit from the Monday following the end of a young person's full-time non advanced education or approved training until they:

- start paid work for 24 hours or more a week, or
- start a course which is not an approved training course, or
- start a course of advanced education, or
- are awarded Income Support, income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, Incapacity Benefit, Employment & Support Allowance or tax credits in their own right.

You must tell us straight away if any of these changes happen. If none of these changes happen, Child Benefit will stop:

- at the end of the extended benefit period (20 weeks from the date the young person leaves full-time non advanced education or approved training), or
- when the young person reaches age 18 during the extended benefit period.
