YOUR NOTICE TO FILE ONLINE FOR TAX YEAR ENDING 5 APRIL 2006

Thank you for filing online for 2003-04.

This letter tells you what you must do for tax year 2005-06. It does not alter what you have to do for 2004-05.

We think that you had **between 50 and 249 employees** in your PAYE scheme on

This means that **for 2005-06 you must file online your Employer's Annual Return (P14s and P35), due by 19 May 2006**, or face a penalty.

How to appeal

You can appeal if you think you had fewer than 50 employees on

Write to the address at the top of this letter within 30 days and tell us how many you actually had on
Please show your employer's PAYE reference.

Please show this letter to your agent, payroll bureau or whoever helps you with your payroll. If you are a payroll agent or bureau, please give a copy of this letter to your client who has this employer's PAYE reference.

Electronic payment
