£250 TAX-FREE IF YOU FILE ONLINE FOR TAX YEAR ENDING 5 APRIL 2006

Thank you for filing online for 2003-04.

You can be £250 better off if you file online for the tax year 2005-06. This letter does not alter what you have to do for 2004-05.

We think that you had **fewer than 50 employees** in your PAYE scheme on

You will get £250 tax-free if you file online your 2005-06 Employer's Annual Return (P14s and P35).

Get up to £825 tax-free

Under Government proposals, you do not have to file your return online until at least 2010.

You can get £250 if you have fewer than 50 employees and file online for 2004-05. And:

file your 2005-06 return online and get	£250
file your 2006-07 return online and get	£150
file your 2007-08 return online and get	£100
file your 2008-09 return online and get	£ 75

Please show this letter to your agent, payroll bureau or whoever helps you with your payroll. If you are a payroll agent or bureau, please give a copy of this letter to your client who has this employer's PAYE reference.

Electronic payment
