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Introduction

These tables show the number of in-work claimants of Child Tax Credit (CTC) and Working Tax Credit (WTC) in award in each local authority (county, district and unitary authority) and in each parliamentary constituency at 3 December 2004.

The tables are consistent with the figures of in-work families in award in each country of the United Kingdom, and in each Government Office Region, shown in Table 8.2 of "Child and Working Tax Credit Statistics. December 2004". This table is reproduced in this volume.

The local authority and constituency of each sample case was identified using the postcode held on the tax credits computer system. These postcodes were matched to the May 2004 Postcode Directory supplied by the Office for National Statistics for Great Britain and the May 2003 Directory supplied by Northern Ireland.

Some cases had postcodes that did not appear in these Directories. Other such cases, and cases with no postcode, are allocated to "Foreign and not known".

The "All in award" figures include both families with positive awards and families with zero awards, based on their circumstances at the reference date and their annual income reported by that date. Families with zero awards at the reference date may have positive awards at other times in the year, based on their circumstances then, and may finally qualify for positive annual awards based on all their circumstances in the year and their current year incomes.

"Recipients" includes only families with positive awards at the reference date. The tables show all recipients, and recipients receiving CTC (split between those with awards above the family element and others). Families with awards tapered to zero and families receiving WTC but not CTC are not shown separately; most estimates of their numbers would have very large relative sampling errors.

The figures are estimates based on a sample comprising 10 per cent of single adults and 20 per cent of couples with awards at the reference date. The Appendix shows how to find the sampling uncertainties associated with the figures shown in these tables; and the uncertainties associated with the "All with awards" figures are shown in the tables. These uncertainties can be quite large in relation to the sizes of the estimates themselves, so care should be taken to ensure that any inferences drawn from the figures are statistically valid. This particularly applies to inferred changes over time.

Estimates based on fewer than 25 cases are particularly subject to uncertainty, and are therefore shown as "-". Estimates for the City of London and Isles of Scilly are combined with those for neighbouring local authorities.

Appendix: Sampling method and sampling error

The tables are based on a random sample of families with CTC or WTC awards at the reference date. The sample comprises 10 per cent of such single adults (with or without children) and 20 per cent of such couples. Each figure in the tables is derived by weighting the relevant sample cases by the inverses of these sampling fractions¹.

The figures in the tables are therefore estimates, but we know how accurate they are. For example, suppose that there are 10,000 couples in an area. This number is not known, and we are to estimate it via the sample. Each couple is sampled with a probability of 0.2. Statistical theory says that there is a 95 per cent probability that the number sampled will lie between 1,922 and 2,078, and that the resulting estimate will lie between 9,610 and 10,390. At least approximately, then, where an estimate of 10,000 is derived from the sample, the true figure lies between these figures, with a 95 per cent probability. That is, the "95 per cent confidence interval" for the estimate is the estimate itself plus or minus 390.

The width of the confidence interval varies with the size of the estimate and the sampling fraction, as shown in the table below. For estimates that comprise a mixture of couples and single adults, the figures will lie between the two sets shown, according to the mix.
