Introduction

These tables show the number of recipients of Working Families' Tax Credit (WFTC) and Disabled Person's Tax Credit (DPTC) in each country of the United Kingdom, in each region of England, in each local authority (county, district and unitary authority) and in each Westminster constituency, together with details of their awards.

WFTC is available to families with at least one adult in remunerative work for at least 16 hours per week, and responsible for at least one child under 16 (under 19 if in full-time education up to A-level or equivalent standard). DPTC is available to people who are in remunerative work for at least 16 hours per week, and who have an illness or disability which puts them at a disadvantage in getting a job.

Awards normally cover 26 weeks. These tables cover recipients with awards current at 31 May 2001 (that is, with start and end dates spanning this date). They are derived from an analysis of all awards. The data were extracted about five months after the reference date. The awards were assessed on the basis of the families' incomes and circumstances on dates between December 2000 and May 2001.

Although the tables show unrounded numbers of recipients in each area, they are not precise counts. There are some recipients whose local authority or constituency has not been identified (see the Technical note for more details).

To ensure that information about individuals is not disclosed, most cells containing fewer than five cases are shown as '-', and most figures for the City of London and the Isles of Scilly are combined with those for adjacent authorities.

Relationship between these tables and the Quarterly Enquiries

The WFTC and DPTC Quarterly Enquiries provide more details about tax credit recipients and their awards (for example, family size and composition, employment status, occupations, hours worked, earnings bands, other income, sizes of awards, types of childcare, duration on award and qualifying benefits for DPTC).

The WFTC Quarterly Enquiry for May 2001 was based on 5 per cent sample of awards in Great Britain. These tables are based on an analysis of all awards. The differences between the figures in the Enquiry and in these tables are mainly due to sampling errors in the former, although smaller differences also result from the later extract date and from some improved procedures for identifying local areas.

Main aggregates

There were 1,281 thousand recipients of WFTC and DPTC at 31 May 2001. 6 per cent were in Wales, 9.3 per cent in Scotland and 3.6 per cent in Northern Ireland.

1,265 thousand recipients had children. A total of 2.48 million children were in these families. 147 thousand recipients were benefiting from the childcare tax credit.

30 thousand disabled workers received DPTC, of which 14 thousand had children and 16 thousand had no children.

Technical note - allocating recipients to local areas

For most recipients, the country, region (for England), county, district and Westminster constituency were identified by matching the postcode recorded as part of the correspondence address against the 2001 Version A Postcode Directory supplied by the Office for National Statistics. The local areas thereby identified were according to their definitions at the end of December 2000.

Some recipients had no recorded postcode, and for others the postcode contained errors (although a spot check revealed that these resulted in very few incorrect identifications of local areas). Where the postcode, or the element recorded, was insufficient to identify the local authority and constituency with certainty, other sources of information were pursued to identify them, where possible.

Recipients with local areas not identified - Great Britain

The local authority was still not identified for 882 recipients in Great Britain (0.07 per cent). For most of these, the reason was that no postcode was recorded. The countries of these recipients were identified by inspecting the addresses. Those in England appear under "Region not identified" in the regional tables; those in Wales and Scotland appear under "Local authority not known" in the local authority table.

For a further 428 recipients (0.03 per cent), their postcodes were not linked to a constituency in the Postcode Directory and the other sources of information pursued gave no link. They are included under "Constituency not identified" in the constituency table.

A visual inspection of the addresses of these 1,310 recipients confirmed that they were not strongly clustered in particular areas within their respective countries.

Recipients with local areas not identified - Northern Ireland

The local authority was still not identified for 921 recipients in Northern Ireland (2 per cent). For most, this was due to their postcodes not being linked to local authorities in the Postcode Directory. The postcodes of a further 727 recipients (1.6 per cent) were not linked to to a constituency in the Postcode Directory.

It is not known whether these 1,648 recipients were strongly clustered in particular areas within Northern Ireland. *This should be borne in mind when using the figures for local authorities and constituencies in Northern Ireland.*

Recipients with foreign correspondence addresses.

These are shown separately in the regional tables. They mainly comprise nationals of other EC member states (mostly the Irish Republic) and certain members of the UK armed forces serving abroad.

Appendix - Definitions used in the tables

Regions

These are Government Office Regions, the standard basis for presenting regional government statistics. Their compositions are shown in the local authority table.

Recipients with foreign addresses

These are recipients whose correspondence addresses are abroad (including the Channel Islands and Isle of Man), or include "BFPO".

Nationals of other EC member states are eligible for tax credits if they work in the United Kingdom. Members of the armed forces serving abroad are eligible if the children and a parent live in the United Kingdom (such families for which the correspondence address is in the UK are included in the appropriate areas).

Children

Under 16, or under 19 and in full-time education up to A-level or equivalent.

Childcare tax credit

This is available to lone parents, to couples where both partners work for at least 16 hours per week, and to couples where the non-working partner is incapacitated.

The value of the childcare tax credit is defined, for each family, as the difference between the actual award and the notional award re-calculated excluding the childcare tax credit. It is equal to 70 per cent of the family's eligible childcare costs, subject to the maximum allowed and to the value of the award. The average value is taken over cases where the value is greater than zero (shown in the previous column), NOT over all tax credit recipients with children.

Average gross weekly earnings

The average shown is for the main earner. This was estimated for each recipient by annualising the net weekly earnings and adding back tax and national insurance contributions, estimated assuming that they were deducted at the appropriate annual and weekly rates. However, this is only an approximation to the gross earnings reported, and a small scaling factor was applied to the figures to bring the overall average in line with the WFTC Quarterly Enquiry estimates.

Average weekly award

For each family, the net value is the value of the award. The reduction through the income taper, and hence the notional award before applying the taper, is estimated from the family's net earnings. The figures are therefore approximate.

Disabled workers

These are adults claiming the Disabled Person's Tax Credit.

Self employed

These are recipients for which the main earner has a source of income from self employment and no source of income as an employee.
