## Introduction

These tables show the number of recipients of Working Families' Tax Credit (WFTC) and Disabled Person's Tax Credit (DPTC) in each country of the United Kingdom, in each region of England, in each local authority (county, district and unitary authority), and in each Westminster constituency, together with details of their awards.

WFTC was available to families with at least one adult in remunerative work for at least 16 hours per week, and responsible for at least one child under 16 (under 19 if in full-time education up to A-level or equivalent standard). DPTC was available to people who were in remunerative work for at least 16 hours per week, and who had an illness or disability which put them at a disadvantage in getting a job.

Awards normally covered 26 weeks. These tables cover recipients with awards current at 30 November 2002 (that is, with start and end dates spanning this date). They are derived from an analysis of all awards. The data were extracted about three months after the reference date.

Although the tables show unrounded numbers of recipients in each area, they are not precise counts. There are some recipients whose local authority or constituency has not been identified (see the Technical note for more details).

To ensure that information about individuals is not disclosed, most cells containing fewer than five cases are shown as '-', and the DPTC figures for the City of London and the Isles of Scilly are combined with those for adjacent authorities.

### Relationship between these tables and the Quarterly Enquiries

The WFTC and DPTC Quarterly Enquiries provide more details about tax credit recipients and their awards (for example, family size and composition, employment status, occupations, hours worked, earnings bands, other income, sizes of awards, types of childcare, duration on award and qualifying benefits for DPTC).

All the estimates in the November 2002 WFTC Quarterly Enquiry are consistent with the figures in this publication. Details are given in the Enquiry.

## Main aggregates

There were 1,414 thousand recipients of WFTC and DPTC at 30 November 2002.

6 cent were in Wales, 9.4 per cent in Scotland and 3.7 per cent in Northern Ireland.

1,394 thousand recipients had children. A total of 2.71 million children were in these families. 180 thousand recipients were benefiting from the childcare tax credit.

38 thousand disabled workers received DPTC, of which 18 thousand had children and 21 thousand had no children.

## Technical note - allocating recipients to local areas

The country, region (for England), county, district and Westminster constituency of the recipients were identified using the postcode recorded as part of the correspondence address, or determined from the rest of that address. The postcodes were matched with the 2002 Version 3 Gridlink Postcode Directory supplied by the Office for National Statistics (ONS), which identified the associated local areas as at October 2002. *The August 2002 issue of this publication used the Traditional directory. The effects of the switch to the Gridlink version on the total numbers of families with children are shown in the column "PCD change effect"; numbers below 5 have been suppressed. There are no entries for Northern Ireland, for which no Gridlink directory is available.*

For a very small proportion of cases no postcode was present or identified, or the postcode did not appear in the Directory. For some of the latter cases this was because of errors in the initial letters of the postcodes; these were corrected. For other cases the first few characters of the postcode were sufficient to identify the local areas with certainty. For yet other cases ONS was able to assist in identifying the local areas.

### Recipients with local areas not identified - Great Britain

The local authority was still not identified for 752 recipients in Great Britain (0.06 per cent). For most of these, the reason was that no postcode was recorded. The countries of these recipients were identified by inspecting the addresses. Those in England appear under "Region not identified" in the regional tables; those in Wales and Scotland appear under "Local authority not known" in the local authority table.

For a further 307 recipients (0.02 per cent), their postcodes were not linked to a constituency in the Postcode Directory and the other sources of information pursued gave no link. They are included under "Constituency not identified" in the constituency table.

A visual inspection of the addresses of these 1,059 recipients confirmed that they were not strongly clustered in particular areas within their respective countries.

### Recipients with local areas not identified - Northern Ireland

The local authority was still not identified for 993 recipients in Northern Ireland (1.9 per cent). For most, this was due to their postcodes not being linked to local authorities in the Postcode Directory. The postcodes of a further 142 recipients were not linked to a constituency in the Postcode Directory, and other sources of information gave no link

It is not known whether these 1,135 recipients were strongly clustered in particular areas within Northern Ireland. *This should be borne in mind when using the figures for local authorities and constituencies in Northern Ireland.*

### Recipients with foreign correspondence addresses.

These are shown separately in the regional tables. They mainly comprise members of the UK armed forces serving abroad, and nationals of other EEA members states (mostly the Irish republic) working in the UK. *The number has risen since May 2002. Members of the armed forces, and other crown servants, serving abroad, and whose families also lived abroad, were eligible for WFTC only from July 2002.*

## **Appendix - Definitions used in the tables**

### **Regions**

These are Government Office Regions, the standard basis for presenting regional government statistics. Their compositions are shown in the local authority table.

### **Recipients with foreign addresses**

These are recipients whose correspondence addresses are abroad (including the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man), or include "BFPO".

Nationals of other EEA member states were eligible for WFTC and DPTC if they worked in the UK. From July 2002, all members of the UK armed forces, and other crown servants, serving abroad were eligible (but those with UK correspondence addresses that do not include "BFPO" are allocated to local areas).

### **Children**

Under 16, or under 19 and in full-time education up to A-level or equivalent.

### **Childcare tax credit**

This was available to lone parents, to couples where both partners worked for at least 16 hours per week, and to couples where the non-working partner was incapacitated.

The value of the childcare tax credit is defined, for each family, as the difference between the actual award and the notional award re-calculated excluding the childcare tax credit. It is equal to 70 per cent of the family's eligible childcare costs, subject to the maximum allowed and to the value of the award. The average value is taken over cases where the value is greater than zero (shown in the previous column), NOT over all tax credit recipients with children.

### **Average gross weekly earnings**

The average shown is for the main earner. This was estimated for each recipient by annualising the net weekly earnings and adding back tax and national insurance contributions, estimated assuming that they were deducted at the appropriate annual and weekly rates. However, this is only an approximation to the gross earnings reported, and a small scaling factor was applied to the figures to bring the overall average in line with the WFTC Quarterly Enquiry estimates.

### **Average weekly award**

For each family, the net value is the value of the award. The reduction through the income taper, and hence the notional award before applying the taper, is estimated from the family's net earnings. The figures are therefore approximate.

### **Disabled workers**

These are adults claiming the Disabled Person's Tax Credit.

### **Self employed**

These are recipients for which the main earner has a source of income from self employment and no source of income as an employee.
